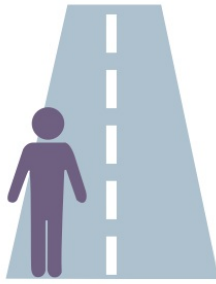


Personalized Learning Roadmap



Fall 2013 - CMS receives a Next Generation Innovation grant from the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation

A system design team (PL) was created to research what PL looks like in other schools/districts through visitations and interviews

CMS charts a path to foster an instructional shift and creates an implementation, change management and resource plan

+ PHASE 1: Invitations are sent to all schools within the district for interest
 PHASE 2: Triangulation of screening criteria is gathered by the PL team to verify readiness
 PHASE 3: Schools submit applications scored by multiple readers based on a comprehensive rubric
 PHASE 4: Local Superintendents approve each schools' participation
 PHASE 5: School visits and interviews are conducted and scored based on a rubric

July 2014 - First cohort of 15 schools for the 2014-2015 school year attend the PL Institute - a definition of PL was created for CMS** and Professional Development is offered

Once selected, each school creates a design team comprised of 10 educators from their school along with the principal.

Winter 2013 - Schools are invited to apply for the opportunity to participate in the first cohort.*



**Personalized Learning in Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools aims to develop the whole child and empower them to take ownership of their learning by providing them with multiple pathways to demonstrate mastery learning in order to be successful and productive 21st century citizens in an ever-changing world.

Coaching and Professional Development is provided for every PL school throughout the school year based on their needs.

Each quarter, the PL schools come together as a cohort to review individual and group Glows (what is working) and Grows (what is not)

2015-2016: 18 schools
2016-2017: 13 schools
The total of PL schools is now 46.
